iTester Portal Updates



Greetings,

This is to let you know that we plan to release a few updates for the following Operating Systems *effective Friday, November 21, 2025*. Below are more details for each of these updates along with a few additional updates.

- iPad OS
- Mac OS
- Chrome OS Carrier Extension

iTester iPadOS Update

We are releasing an update to the iTester iPadOS app on November 21 that includes bug fixes and performance improvements.

While updating is not required, to ensure the best experience, we recommend updating all iPads intended for testing to the latest version by following the steps below:

Steps to Update the iTester App on iPadOS

- If Automatic Updates Are Enabled:
 - No action is needed. The iTester app will update automatically when a new version is available.
- If Automatic Updates Are NOT Enabled, then do the following:
 - 1. Open the App Store on your iPad.

- 2. Tap your **Apple ID icon** or profile picture in the top-right corner.
- 3. Scroll down to view pending updates.
- 4. Find the iTester app in the list.
- 5. Tap **Update** next to the iTester app.

MacOS Update

We're releasing an updated version of our macOS kiosk on November 21 to ensure full compatibility with macOS Tahoe (version 26).

- This update follows a period of extensive testing and resolves a key compatibility issue identified between our previous kiosk installer and macOS 26.
- Schools that have already installed the older version of the macOS kiosk may continue using it.

Chrome OS Update

We plan to release an update to the iTester ChromeOS Carrier Extension on November 21, along with Mac and iPad updates.


All Chromebook devices will automatically receive this update once it is deployed. No action will be required on the part of the school or district.


User Upload Data Definitions Added

We have added a **User Upload Data Definitions File** to the portal, under the Users tab when you click to **Import Users**.

This will help Test Administrators with uploading users, having a data file definition alongside the import template. Similar to the Student Registration process, this will help users understand the expected data structure and formatting requirements.

This update will go live on November 25, 2025.





New User Email Notification Update

When we consolidated to a single email sent to new users to login to their portal accounts, the **Username** was excluded in the email body. We have already made this change on the backend and will now go to Production. This will clear up **Username** confusion with new users logging into the portal. **This update will go live on November 25, 2025.**

- All user roles except <u>Test Administrator</u>, <u>Reports Access Only</u>, and <u>IT Coordinator</u> have this permission currently on UAT.
